# **AAOMS Media Information and Policy Agreement**

## **Meeting information**

Credentialed media representatives are welcome and encouraged to attend most scientific sessions and lectures. The American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons (AAOMS) should be credited in published coverage that results from information presented at the 2025 AAOMS Annual Meeting.

Note: Opinions and information shared in sessions, interviews or informal conversations do not necessarily reflect the views or endorsement of AAOMS.

## Media registration and eligibility

AAOMS provides complimentary media credentials to verified media representatives who register for the meeting. Note: *Individuals registered as exhibitors are not eligible to register as media.* 

#### Use of media credentials

Media representatives covering sessions must comply with all attendee policies and observe the following guidelines:

- Television cameras/crews are prohibited in educational sessions. On-camera interviews must be arranged in advance with AAOMS Communications staff and conducted in public areas.
- Audio recording in educational sessions is prohibited unless authorized in advance and used solely for personal note-taking.
- Videotaping of educational sessions is strictly prohibited.
- If a session is full or near capacity, media must stand at the back of the room.

AAOMS reserves the right to limit or deny media access to specific sessions. Staff stationed at each session entrance will inform media representatives if the session is closed to the press. Please refer back to the 107th AAOMS Annual Meeting, Scientific Sessions and Exhibition Media Information Sheet for a list of sessions closed to media.

#### Media badge revocation

Violations of the media policy will result in immediate revocation of media credentials for the current meeting and may affect eligibility for future AAOMS events. Media representatives are in violation if they:

- Sell, market or represent a company to solicit advertising, subscriptions or other business from attendees or exhibitors.
- Promote or market a product or service featured at the Annual Meeting.
- Misrepresent their affiliation or intent to obtain media credentials.
