

AAOMSopoly Mobile App Game – Official Rules

The American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons (AAOMS) is hosting AAOMSopoly at the 108th Annual Meeting Exhibition to be held Sept. 30 to Oct. 2 at the Seattle Convention Center Summit in Seattle, Wash. AAOMSopoly is a skill-based contest. Eligible participants are all registered in-person attendees of the current Annual Meeting. Awards have been furnished by AAOMS and will be presented to top-performing participants after the 2026 Annual Meeting. By participating, entrants agree to abide by these Official Rules.

1. THE CONTEST – Awards furnished by AAOMS will be presented to the highest-performing participants as determined exclusively by the criteria in Rule 8 after the conclusion of the 2026 Annual Meeting. All winners will be notified by email.

2. NO PURCHASE NECESSARY – No purchase, subscription or acceptance of any obligation is necessary to enter or participate in this contest.

3. SKILL CONTEST – NOT A GAME OF CHANCE – Winners are determined exclusively by demonstrated knowledge and performance on questions answered correctly at participating exhibitor booths as described in Rule 8. No element of chance or random selection determines or influences winner selection.

4. ELIGIBILITY – All registered in-person attendees who are at least 18 years of age and officially registered for the 108th Annual Meeting, Scientific Sessions and Exhibition may participate.

5. HOW TO PARTICIPATE – Participants play the mobile app game by scanning participating exhibitor companies' QR codes within their booths and answering the questions presented. Participation alone does not determine winners; only performance on the criteria in Rule 8 determines award recipients.

6. NUMBER OF ENTRIES – Only one entry per mobile app user is permitted.

7. WINNER DETERMINATION – A participant may receive only one award. Winners are determined solely by the performance criteria described in Rule 8. No random selection mechanism is used in determining winners. Winners must verify their eligibility with AAOMS.

8. AWARDS AND THEIR VALUE – Awards are furnished by AAOMS and include awards determined by AAOMS in its sole discretion, including free registration to the 2027 AAOMS Annual Meeting and Dental Implant Conference.

9. SKILL-BASED WINNER SELECTION – The top 13 participants will be selected based exclusively on the following objective, criteria applied in order:

- **Primary Criterion:** The highest number of correctly answered questions across all participating exhibitor booths visited.
- **Secondary Criterion (Tiebreaker 1):** In the event of a tie, the participant who achieved the highest correct-answer score in the fewest total questions attempted will be ranked higher.

- **Tertiary Criterion (Tiebreaker 2):** In the event of a remaining tie, the participant who completed correct answers in the shortest cumulative time, as recorded by the mobile app, will be ranked higher.

No random drawing or chance-based mechanism will be used at any stage of winner selection. Results will be tabulated within fourteen (14) business days after the 2026 Annual Meeting concludes. Decisions of AAOMS regarding tabulation and winner selection are final and binding. A winner may waive the right to receive an award. Awards are non-assignable and non-transferable. No substitutions are allowed by the recipient. Awards are subject to availability, and AAOMS reserves the right to substitute items of equal or lesser value.

10. AWARD RECIPIENT NOTIFICATION – Winners need not be present at the conclusion of the Annual Meeting. They will be notified by AAOMS after results are tabulated. If AAOMS cannot reach a winner after reasonable efforts, that individual will relinquish the right to claim the award, and AAOMS may present the award to the next highest-ranked eligible participant. Acceptance of an award constitutes permission to use the winner’s name to inform members of the results. Winners will be announced on AAOMS.org and through AAOMS communications as soon as practicable after notification.

11. APPLICABLE LAWS – The conduct of AAOMSopoly and the disposition of awards are subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws, including the laws of the State of Washington. AAOMS reserves the right to substitute an award of equal or lesser value if the stated award becomes unavailable. Award recipients may not request alternative awards or cash equivalents.

12. TAXES AND COSTS – The winner is solely responsible for reporting and payment of any taxes on received award. AAOMS will comply with applicable tax reporting requirements. Participants are responsible for any costs incurred in attending the Annual Meeting and participating in this contest.

13. RELEASE OF LIABILITY – By participating, each entrant agrees to indemnify, release and hold harmless AAOMS and all officers, Trustees, members, employees and agents from any and all actions, causes of action, claims, demands, losses, damages, expenses or liabilities resulting in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, from that entrant’s participation in this contest and the acceptance, use or misuse of any award received.
